WHY GO PAPERLESS

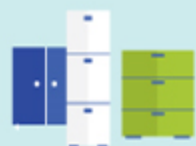
Because it'll make you feel good about yourself. Not only will you be doing the environment a favor, you'll also be improving both your personal and professional lives.

SAVE TREES

It takes about 2.4 trees to produce 10 reams (500 sheets) of non-recycled office and printing paper



SAVE SPACE

SAVE MONEY

The average office worker uses 10,000 sheets of copy paper each year. Studies show the cost of using paper in your office runs from 13-31 times the cost of actually purchasing it!

Professionals spend about 50% of their time searching for information, and roughly 18 minutes on average locating each document



SAVE DATA

Paper copies are often lost or misplaced, which is why digitizing your documents is the way to go. You can protect sensitive information by encrypting your docs with passwords and saving copies of your work in the cloud
